Dear fellow weavers,

this is an update from the May 30 meeting of the Chimneyville Weavers Guild, as well as nominating ballot and announcement for the next two meetings in June.

These were our decisions:

- 1) Starting with the month of June we will always meet the second Saturday of the month. When necessary additional meetings may be called. The time will usually be 10:00 a.m. (see below for exceptions), but regardless of time, meetings will start PROMPTLY. Lunch breaks will be scheduled. The meeting place will change with the nature of the meeting. Business meeting will be the first order of business, followed by a workshop or program.
- 2) Starting with this notice we will be sending our own notices (as opposed to being sent by the Craftsmen Guild). Members present at the meeting contributed \$1.00 to defray the cost of mailing this. Each member who is interested in staying active should bring 12 legal size invelopes, stamped and self-addressed, to the June meeting. UNLESS SANDI RECEIVES ENVELOPES BY JUNE 13, YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE FURTHER NOTICES.
- 3) Officers will be elected as discussed below and they will take office as of July meeting. In the interim various people are sharing the responsibilities. The job descriptions of the offices will be:

DIRECTOR will be responsible for holding meetings, keeping the schedule and for leader-ship of the Guild.

ASSISTANT DIRECTOR will be the Program Chairman, responsible for scheduling workshop and programs. This person would also become Director in case the present Director resigns, moves, etc.

SECRETARY will keep minutes, membership list updated, send notices and collect envelopes for the mailings.

TREASURER will collect dues (which will be voted on later), donations and will be Ways and Means Chairman, that is, will be responsible for fund raisers so that we may have money for outside teachers without having to charge an exorbitant fee to our members. LIASON will deal with those matters that directly involve the Craftsmen Guild, such as workshops, exhibits at Chimneyville, etc.

This is a brief discussion of the offices. Sandi Pace and Marcy Petrini will have ready by the June meeting a draft of the directives for our Guild. These are like by-laws, but cannot strictly be called as such since we are officially an arm of the Craftsmen Guild and thus abide according to their Constitution and By-Laws. These directives will be discussed during the June meeting.

4) This is the procedure we will follow to elect officers: Use the space provided below to NOMINATE people for the various offices. You need not contact the nominee as that will be done for all those receiving enough nominations to be placed on the ballot. Self-nominations are acceptable. Bring the nominations to the June meeting or mail them to Sandi if you will not be at the meeting. Nominations will be tabulated at the June meeting. The two people receiving the most nominations for each office will be placed on the ballot, provided they accept. If one person receives nominations for more than one office the nominee will decide which office (s)he would like to run for. Ballots will be mailed to all those who will have provided self-addressed, stamped envelopes. Ballots will have to be returned BEFORE the July meeting, since during that meeting "installation" will take place.
