

A WEAVING WORKSHOP WITH ELIZABETH DICE
SATURDAY SEPT. 22 AND SUNDAY SEPT. 23, 1984*

to include: leno lace variations, iaid-in, oukesans, pile, flosses, rya, Ghordes Knots, soumak, Danish medallion, Brooks bouquet, Spanish lace, loopins, crossed weft technique... and more (all done on a straight draw!)

This workshop will be tailored to individual needs, with each student working on only one loom at her/his own speed. This workshop is for you IF:

- 1) You'd like to learn some or all of the above!
- 2) You are a beginner weaver
- 3) You haven't been weaving and you need an extra little push to get you started again.
- 4) You would like to add a touch of class to your handwovens in an easy way.
- 5) You need some inspiration! (and who doesn't!)

Spend 2 days on one technique or learn them all! Ms. Dice has a reputation not only of being a wonderful teacher, but also a very patient one!

Ms. Dice has taught weaving and art from grade school to college, including at the Mississippi College for Women where she was from 1945 till her recent retirement. She has a Master in Design from the U. of Michigan as well as an MA in Art History from Indiana U. She has extensive weaving experience and includes Else Resensteiner among her teachers.

Looms should be dressed prior to the workshop; we suggest that you bring your own loom so that you can take it home and practice on the left over warp. Rigid heddle looms are fine. There will be looms available at Chimneysville, but weaving classes will resume shortly after the workshop, so warps can't stay at the looms.

The fee for the workshop is \$. Yarns will be the responsibility of the weaver, but chocolet cotton is all that is required for warps.

If you are interested in the workshop, sign up as soon as possible. Your place will be reserved after payment has been received; you will then receive specific directions about warping the loom and yarns needed. Registration fee is not refundable. Registration will close September 7 (before if the workshop is filled). No directions will be mailed after that date.
