
Of interest to all is the Show of WEAVINGS by HELEN BRYANT at the Municipal Art Gallery on North State Street.

Dear Fiber Craftsman and Artist:

The Tupelo Artist Guild is sponsoring a show, "Mississippi Textiles" to which you are invited to submit a piece.

The show is in conjunction with the Textile Conference that Robert Reedy is organizing and will occurr in Tupelo toward the end of February. The show will exhibit all facets of fine textiles: from fiber manipulation to surface design to fabric art.

I need the pieces by December 27, 1985 to be included in the catalogue; the show will continue to the end of February. The Artist Guild will be sending pieces directly back to you at the end of the show. Pieces can be for sale, for which a small commission (less_than 20%) will be charged.

Please send pieces directly to me at the above address. Please tag each piece with the following:

Name of piece

Medium/ fiber content

Price (if for sale) or NFS + the \$ value for insurance purposes

Cleaning instructions (if for sale and where appropriate)

Name of craftsman

address

phone number(s)

Please note that the December 27 deadline falls within the Christmas holidays, so if you are mailing pieces, allow plenty of time. You are welcomed to drop pieces at the above address during evenings and weekends any time between now and the deadline, but please call first. I will also be at the Craftsman Guild Show in December and I will be glad to pick up pieces then.

I think that this is an exciting opportunity to have Mississippi fibers displayed together in an elegant setting; furthermore, this is the first time, to my knowledge, that a show of such an extensive scope will have been organized in Mississippi. You will hear more about the Textile Conference directly from Robert Reedy, but I can tell you that the partecipants are internationally recognized by the fiber community. We want to show them the fine quality and breath of our fiber arts.
