


directions for EVENING JACKET





- 2. To make tucks in jackets, bring lines together and stitch down 7½". Press center tuck flat and remaining tucks as shown.
- 3. Baste across upper edge of tucks.
- 4. Bring side corner with pleats(A) up to B. Stitch front to back at shoulders. Finish inside seam.
 - 5. Finish raw edge around neck with a commercial or handwoven band. It can be long enough to go around the bottom hem, if you like.
