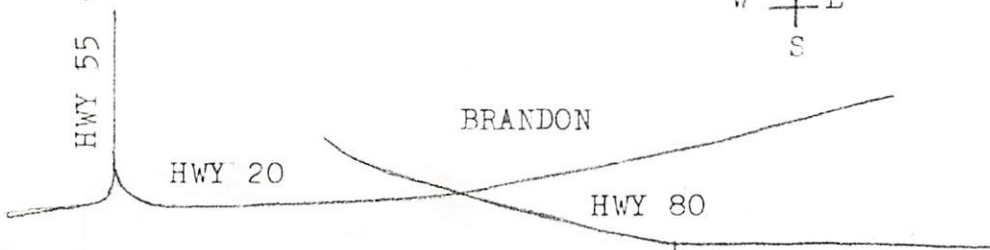


On corner of Fairview & Pine in the 2nd block off of N. State

MAP VERY DEFINITELY NOT TO SCALE!

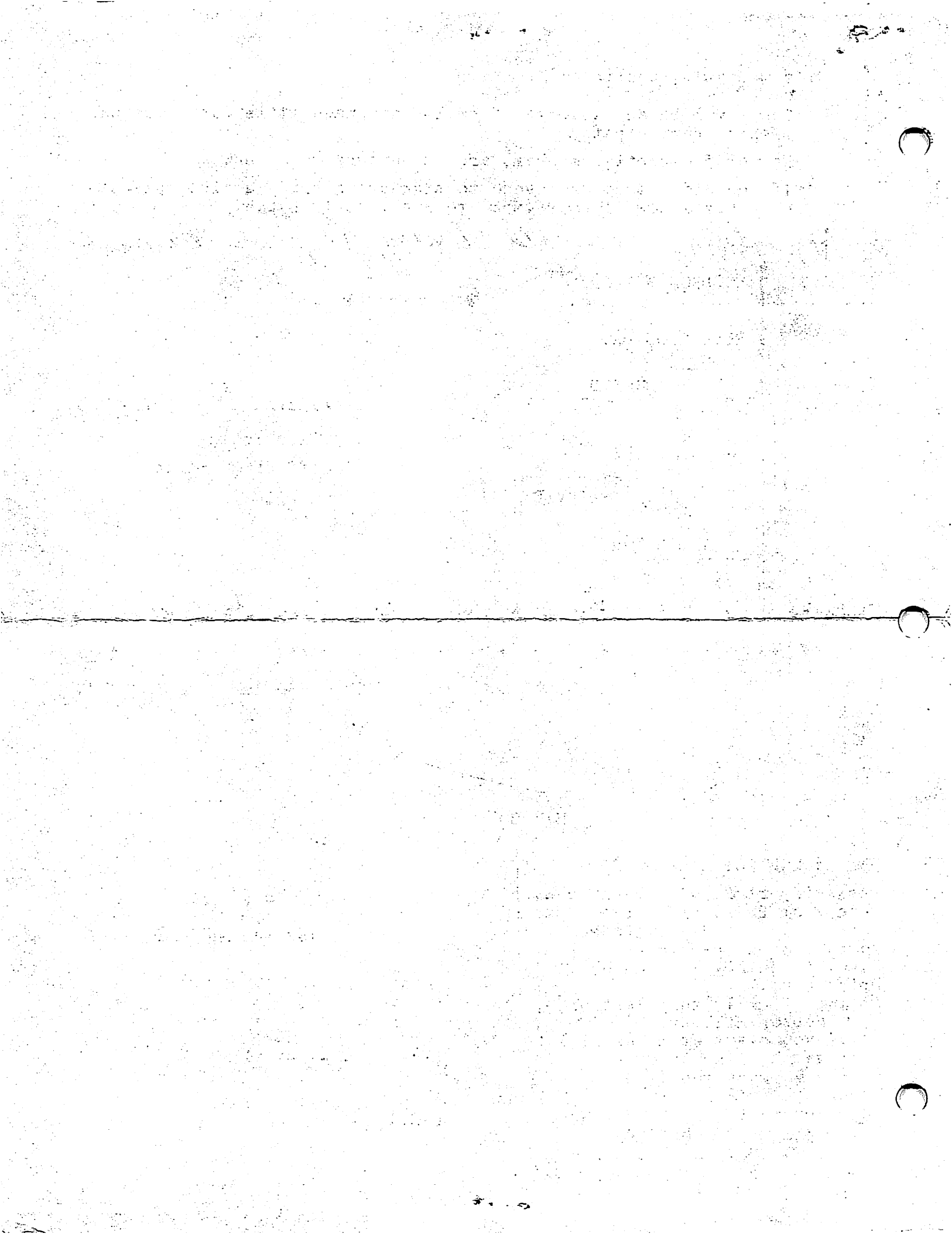


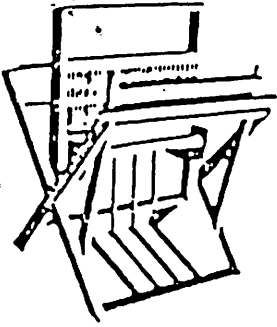
55s to Hwy 20, East on 20

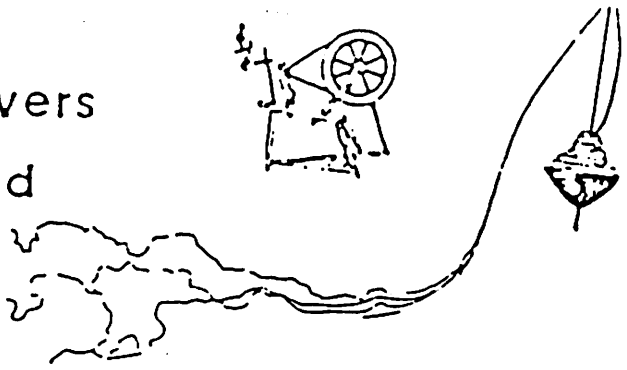

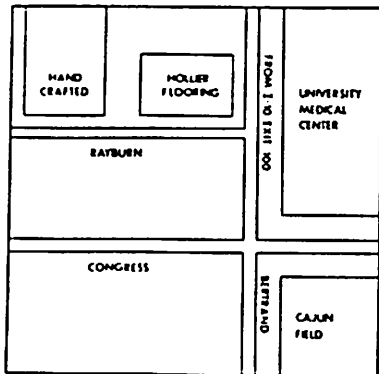
SHOW AND TELL: Share with us fibers you have spun, articles you have woven - especially the triangular shawls started at the New Orleans workshop.
