### From the Lab

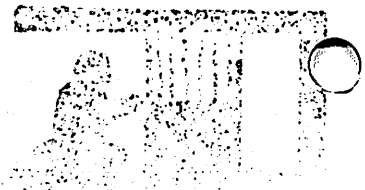

WEFT-FACE RUG WEAVING CLASS - January 14 - March 17: The Craftsmen's Guild of Mississippi is offering a 10-week class on weft-face rug weaving beginning January 14. This class covers a variety of loom controlled patterns possible on twill and block threadings with a widely set warp and the weft totally covering it. Small sample rugs, 8" X 10", will be woven since this kind of weaving is rather slow. ¶ Class meets on Tuesday nights from 7:00 until 9:00 p.m., from January 14 through March 17. Cost is \$75 plus \$15 loom rental fee. Beginning weaving and a good understanding of twills is necessary for enrollment. Warps will be provided but students provide their own weft yarns, which will be discussed during the first class. ¶ Instructor is Marcy Petrini, exhibiting member of the Craftsmen's Guild and a winner of the 1987 teacher of Merit Award. Enrollment is limited and preregistration and prepayment are required; spaces will be offered on a first-come, first-served basis. Also, fees are non-refundable for cancellations less than two weeks in advance. For more information call 981-0019.
