The participating group will rent a studio for use during the colony. The hours are roughly 8 a.m. into the evening. Everyone would bring a project, whether weaving, spinning, knitting, rug hooking, sewing, and can come and go at their convenience. The group would have a key to secure the room.

The cost for a studio accommodating 2-4 people is \$275. A larger studio for 5-10 people is \$375. The final studio cost will be evenly divided among participants when the group registers.
