

Rust Dyeing with Color— CWSG Program for October

Intrigued by a *Shuttle Spindle and Dyepot* article two years ago, CWSG president Winki Allen set out to learn rust dyeing. She experimented with rust dyeing, then combined it with the natural dyeing techniques of India Flint. Next, in weekly sessions, Winki and Nancy Landrum incorporated teas, coffee, berries, onion skins, leaves and more. A trip to John C. Campbell this summer for a surface design class further inspired Winki. Now she has authored her own rust dyeing article for the summer issue of *SS & D* and will share her knowledge of rust dyeing with CWSG members at the Oct. meeting.

Thanks so much from CWSG! This will be a hard act to follow.


It was so good to see all of you in September. Come join us in October, if you can. Bring show-and-tell items and your prayer flag too!
